

Detailed programme

General – 1 hr

- basic 3D elements: light source (left, above, front), shadows on sphere, cube, parallelepiped, cone

Flowers & leaves structure – 7 hrs

- single flowers shapes:
 - 3D disc;
 - cone;
 - trumpet-like;
 - bell-like;
 - cup- or bowl-like;
 - tube-like;
 - 4- or 5-point star-like;
- composite flowers shapes:
 - plume;
 - spike;
 - cluster;
- main parts of a flower
- leaves shapes:
 - hand-like;
 - spear-like;
 - heart-like;
 - round;
 - needle-like;
 - ribbon-like;
 - fan-like;
- main parts of a leaf
- views from above, back and side
- curled petals, lips and leaves.

Flowers & leaves arrangement – 1 hr

- The rule of three/odd numbers;
- variety of angles;
- variety of shapes, textures/colours;
- movement of the elements;
- examples of arrangements.

Bonus

- Revision of a drawing of student's choice.

Supply

- A3 drawing or mixed-media paper sheets, a clear plastic rubber, an H lead pencil, a pencil-sharpener
